### **Alexander Bezborodov participated in the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference “Compliance - enlargement of borders”**

Moscow was the venue for the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference “Compliance - enlargement of borders”, held on 23 May 2019. This year the conference was held under the aegis of Compliance Space – a new project of ICS, the exclusive partner of International Compliance Association (ICA). Over 300 compliance management executives and specialists of the largest Russian and foreign organizations participated in the conference.
